

Wall Lake City Council met in council chambers at 5:30 p.m. presided by Mayor Rohlf.

Councilmen present: Schroeder, Riedell, Steinkamp and Nuetzman.

Visitors: Curtis Bloes.

Riedell made the motion to approve the agenda. Steinkamp seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Nuetzman made the motion to approve the minutes of the July 14th meeting as presented. Schroeder seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Steinkamp made the motion to approve the bills as presented with additional bills submitted by Sac County Engineer and Schroeder Pest Control. The bill from Windstream needs to be deleted. Nuetzman seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Public Forum: Nuetzman spoke to council about the Dog Park, is this idea still being considered? A group of Wall Lake citizens would like to see this become a reality and are willing to maintain the dog park.

Discuss/Approve Marketing with Blue Space or Break Thru 360: The Clerk reported that Blue Space is a little more expensive than Break Thru 360. Schroeder stated that he thinks Blue Space has more experience and would be more involved in the social media aspect of the marketing of Wall Lake. This will be discussed further at the next council meeting.

Discuss/ Approve Auburn Electric Agreement: The Clerk reached out to Auburn about the cost increases. Auburn will have on their next council meeting to discuss the increase. Schroeder made the motion to approve the agreement as presented. Nuetzman seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Discuss/Approve Trees 4 Kids Grant for Golf course: The City will purchase 13 trees and a portion of the cost for the trees will be reimbursed from a grant. 4H will plant the trees.

Schroeder made the motion to approve the Trees for Kids project. Steinkamp seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Discuss/Approve Liquor License Slush Up and Drink: Schroeder made the motion to approve the liquor license for Slush Up and Drink. Steinkamp seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Discuss/Approve Building Permit(s) Schroeder made the motion to approve the building permit for Jan Kolar. Nuetzman seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Discuss/Approve Cemetery grave digging price increase: Our grave diggers have requested a dig pay increase. Council agreed that costs for equipment repairs, etc. have increased. Nuetzman made the motion to approve the full burial dig price from \$500 to \$600. A cremation dig will increase from \$375 to \$425. Grave diggers fee will increase from \$125 to \$150 each for both full burial and cremation digs. Riedell seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Discuss/Approve Mayor Appointments: Mayor Rohlf informed council that he has been struggling to find and appoint a new cemetery sexton and asked if council has any suggestions.

Discuss/Approve FY2025 Year End: The Clerk informed the council that this will be coming up soon and will need to be reviewed by council.

Discuss/ Approve Resolution 2025-18; a Resolution Deleting Property from the Wall Lake Commercial/Industrial Urban Renewal Area: Riedell made the motion to approve Resolution 2025-18. Steinkamp seconded. Roll Call Vote: Schroeder;yes, Riedell;yes, Steinkamp;yes and Nuetzman; yes. Motion carried.
