Lahr made the motion to approve the agenda. Schwanz seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Steinkamp made the motion to approve the minutes from the February 22nd meeting. Schwanz seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Schwanz made the motion to approve the bills to be paid as presented with Riedell's approval. Rohlf seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSAL TO ENTER INTO AN ELECTRIC REVENUE LOAN AGREEMENT

At 7:02 p.m. the Mayor opened the Public Hearing. The Clerk did not receive any comments or question from the public. Steinkamp motioned to close the Public Hearing at 7:03 p.m. Rohlf seconded. Roll Call vote: Rohlf;yes, Schwanz;yes, Steinkamp;yes, Lahr;yes. Motion carried.

Steinkamp made the motion to close the Public Hearing on the proposal to enter into an electric revenue loan agreement. Rohlf seconded. Roll Call vote: Rohlf;yes, Schwanz;yes, Steinkamp;yes, Lahr;yes. Motion carried.

Discuss/Approve Proclamation of Football Field Naming: At this time Mayor Druivenga read a proclamation naming the football field Cadwell Field in honor of his remarkable football coaching career. Coach Cadwell's career spanned from 1976-2000. His record was 164-62 and was 6 time playoff qualifier. In 2020 Coach Cadwell was inducted into the Iowa Coaches Hall of Fame. Congratulations to Coach Cadwell.

Discuss/Approve Resolution 2021-05 FY2022 budget: Steinkamp made the motion to approve Resolution 2021-05 FY2022 budget. Rohlf seconded. Roll Call vote: Rohlf;yes, Schwanz;yes, Steinkamp;yes, Lahr;yes. Motion carried.

Discuss/Approve Spring Cleanup: Council discussed Spring Clean up now that Rudd Sanitation is picking up for us. There will be more discussion in a future meeting on cleanup date and time.

Discuss/Approve Liquor License Jamboree Foods: Steinkamp made the motion to approve the liquor license, Lahr seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Discuss/Approve Natural Gas Meter Charge: Gas meters were installed in 1998 and are getting older needing replaced. A gas meter charge would help with cost of new meters. The Clerk would like the council to think about and discuss in a future meeting.

Discuss/Approve Resolution 2021-06; a Resolution taking additional action on proposal to enter into an Electric Revenue Loan Agreement: Steinkamp made the motion to approve Resolution 2021-06. Schwanz seconded. Roll Call vote: Rohlf;yes, Schwanz;yes, Steinkamp;yes, Lahr;yes. Motion carried.

Discuss/Approve Street/Lot on Pool Drive (somebody wants to buy and put up shed) Steinkamp made the motion to put an ad in paper for sealed bids on a lot by the pool with a deadline of April 9th. Rohlf seconded. Roll Call vote: Rohlf;yes, Schwanz;yes, Steinkamp;yes, Lahr;yes. Motion carried.

Public Forum

Steinkamp asked if we have anything in our ordinance about a golf cart being used after dark, currently a golf cart cannot be on the streets after dusk. The clerk told the council that is something they would need to discuss if they want that changed.

Cheryl Rohlf addressed the council and told them she was interested in the Pool Manager position if no one else has applied. The council suggested running an ad again in the paper since no applications were received previously. Rohlf informed the council that there is a grant available for volunteer Fire Departments by Safer Grant for an LED sign.
