Wall Lake City Council met in council chambers at 7:00 p.m. presided by Mayor Rohlf.

Councilmen present: Mott, Riedell, Nuetzman, Steinkamp. Germann is absent.

Visitors: Tommy Schroeder and Curtis Bloes.

Nuetzman made the motion to approve the agenda. Mott seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Public Forum:

Discuss/Approve REC Board: There have been a lot of improvements and upgrades done, gym stage ceiling has been painted, new backboards are in, the curtain dividing the gym is in, the floors are going to be redone. Nuetzman reported that the Rec Board agreed that the walls in the gym need improvements. Nuetzman asked what the plans are for the music room and made some suggestions on moving or eliminating some items to make more room in the gym. Improvements will continue as funding is available.

Discuss/Approve Employee wages recommendations: Mott reviewed and presented to council what wage increase recommendations were. Riedell made the motion to approve the wage increase recommendations as presented. Nuetzman seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Discuss/ Approve streets committee recommendations: Due to weather the street committee did not look at streets. They will plan on looking at them soon.

Discuss/Approve interested in selling the park area at the pool or a 1031 for the land East of the pool? The Clerk and the council agreed that they are not interested in selling any land, to stay focused on the city's plan for developing areas previously discussed and not take on any new potential projects.

Discuss/Approve Snyder and Associates Contract for airport sewer and water extension: Riedell made the motion to approve Snyder and Associates contract. Mott seconded. Ayes: All. Motion carried.
